

# Bust a Groove

## Rules and Regulations

### Divisions and Participation Rules

There are four divisions in the competition: solos, duos, Kpop, and 1 vs 1 Battle Division.

- A solo is one dancer who performs on their own. Must be a RMIT Student or alumni.
- A duo is comprised of two dancers. Both participants must be RMIT students or alumni.
- Kpop division can have 2-7 dancers. All participants must be RMIT students or alumni.
- Participants in the 1 vs 1 Battle division must be RMIT students or alumni.

\*The solo and duo divisions are own original choreography or if pre-choreograph must have written permission from choreographer (or can be freestyle by artistic choice) divisions and own music mix/edit needs to be submitted by the due date prior to the event day.

\*The Kpop division is performing a dance cover of the original dance performed by Kpop artists. Groups will be judged on performance and execution. Music needs to be submitted by the due date prior to the event day.

\*Kpop division can only have one kpop group cover/song. No mixing of other Kpop group routines.

\*The Battle Division is freestyle according to the music and rounds offered.

### Music

**You must supply your own music.**

(No swearing or offensive content is permitted)

- Solo Division: Minimum 1 minute & 20 seconds / Maximum 1 minute & 40 Seconds
- Duo Division: Minimum 1 minute & 40 seconds / Maximum 2 minutes
- Kpop Division: 1 full Kpop song can be chosen. No mixes.
- Battle Division will be provided music mixed on the day – you are not required to select a music track. (If you perform less than the minimum required you will be disqualified from the competition)

Submitting your music early before other registered participants will claim you a spot in the competition.

Music must be emailed as an MP3 or MP4 (no .WAV files or URL links) by Tuesday 14 May, 12PM

**No other music forms (USB, phone, iPod etc.) will be accepted on the day.**

### Additional Rules

- No props are allowed on stage.
- No disrobing in a suggestive manner. No excessively revealing clothing. No destroying clothing on stage.
- Must have fun! This is a competition that celebrates dance at RMIT.

Failure to abide by the competition rules will result in consequences to be determined by the event management.
