Side by side with Customers, you will plan initiatives and facilitate our agile development squads in delivery of work meeting goals committed as part of the quarterly planning process. You will work in partnership with vendors, business owners and ITS stakeholders in RMIT.

- Accountable for the design and implementation of technology solutions within the DLX/LMS platform as well as related technologies
- Lead a range of initiatives including projects implementing new features, continuous enhancements and platform improvement related work
- Act as a Subject Matter Expert regarding learning and teaching platforms and ecosystems, leading discussions regarding solution consultation, issue resolution, product improvements and new features.
- Develop and maintain strong, collaborative working relationships.
- Review application release features and sponsor and support delivery teams in the plan the roll out.
- Collaborate with cross-functional teams to ensure alignment (design and function) across the learning and teaching landscape, supporting common usage patterns across RMIT
- Demonstrate excellent cross-group collaboration skills, including conflict resolution and negotiation skills
- Cultivate a culture and mindset of results orientation, agile work practices and business analysis practices to enable initiatives to be delivered efficiently, effectively and aligned to the business value
- Implement, guide and maintain high standards of scrum/agile practices and guardrails within the team including tracking to success metrics against key measures.
- Facilitate sprint outcomes by listening to and making people aware of impediments, build momentum around new practices and help keep the platform management team accountable for their deliverables.
- Communicates and works with key functional groups and key stakeholders to help embed a consistent way of working across the product stream.
- Help manage and mitigate risk whilst exercising sound judgement.

10. Analytical and critical thinker with good experience with facilitation, situational awareness, conflict resolution and continuous improvement
11. Demonstrated experience in Agile implementation and applying relevant SAFE/scrum/agile principles, practices and theories
12. Strong technical aptitude and experience leading teams in delivering quality software
13. Great interpersonal skills for building strong working relationships
