## Remuneration and benefits

At RMIT Vietnam, we value our people and are committed to bringing quality working experience to our employees through excellent working conditions and a wide variety of benefits.

We pay on a 'total fixed remuneration' basis (TFR), which means that the salary stated is your total remuneration. Salary packaging options are available with regards to yearly flights back home to your place of domicile. ^ For Foreign employees, TFR includes base salary, and any salary packaging options that the employee wishes to pursue.

RMIT Vietnam will withhold and pay income tax on your behalf, and assist you with your annual tax documentation

#### Our remuneration levels are as follows:

In addition, for roles with extra responsibilities (for example, Deputy Dean, Head of Department, Senior Program Manager, Program Lead), you will be paid a fixed annual allowance in addition to TFR

#### Other benefits include:

- Relocation allowance of US\$6,000 net. Paid within the month of your start date.
- School tuition support of up to US\$20,000 per child annually, up to 2 children per family.
- Relocation flights for employee and dependents to Vietnam
- International repatriation flights for the staff, their spouse, and children at the end of their contract.
- Salary packaging options for one return airfare to your home country per year.
- 20 days annual leave, up to 10 days public holidays, New Year Day holiday, 5 paid days for Christmas closure, and up to 10 days' sick leave per annum.
- Full private medical insurance for employee and immediate dependents, and Personal Accident Insurance
- Free access to on-site medical center
- Free access to on-site gym and recreational facilities.

## **Relocation and onboarding**

Moving to Vietnam is an exciting opportunity and we want to make it as smooth as possible for you and your family. That's why we offer a comprehensive relocation package that covers your travel expenses, visa arrangements, and settling-in costs.

- Flight from place of domicile to Vietnam for you and your dependents (spouse and/or children).
- \$6,000 USD relocation payment to cover any expenses (temporary accommodation, furniture, rental deposit, etc.)
- Support with temporary accommodation booking, airport pick-up on your arrival, and any other support required
- Bank account opening assistance
- Information on living in Ho Chi Minh City such as realtors, schools, etc.
- Visa, Work Permit, and residence card support

# **Work permit process**

Working in Vietnam requires a valid work permit, which you can obtain if you meet the eligibility criteria. RMIT Vietnam will assist you with the work permit application and cover any related expenses. The process may take 2-4 months, depending on how fast you can submit the required documents. Our mobility team will support you throughout the process.
