- documentation of design process and design ideas
- sustained written work including practice reflection, academic essays or creative writing
- finished garments or prototypes in documented form
- publications, photographs, films or other forms of fashion communication

Under each image provide a brief explanation, including the purpose and background of the work (maximum 50 words).

Include the page number, your full name and application number (if known) on each page.
