Navigating from Swanston Street to the Library (energy-conserving, indoor path with lift access)

Note: this path may require swipe card access.

We start at the RMIT Design Hub in the North-East corner of the intersection of Swanston and La Trobe Street. The building has distinct green decorations that look like clouds. The **intersection may be busy** and there may be construction work. **Watch out for construction signs, obstacles, narrow paths, cyclists, and uneven surfaces**

Walk past RMIT Gallery. The surface is covered in **bluestone**, so it may be **slippery** when wet.

Turn right into Rodda Lane. You will recognise the lane because there is a **large RMIT sign on the floor.** You will see a set of automatic doors leading into Building 8 on the left.

Walk past the sliding doors and turn to the right toward the lift. Note that this area is lit with **fluorescent lights** and lift may require swipe access outside of Open Day
