RMIT's Trades Innovation Centre is a multi-million dollar facility that provides students and industry the latest in innovative skills training and technology.

The Trades Innovation Centre provides an opportunity for industry to test, learn, trial and demonstrate, and access RMIT's expertise to solve real-world problems.

A modular design with a 1,700 square metre footprint allows for multi-use spaces and zones that can expand and contract as needed. This includes a 2.5-metre-deep sand pit, double height ceilings throughout the workshop and a three-storey training rig that simulates a building during construction.

By splitting the centre into 'trade zones', students will learn hands-on skills within view of other trades – leading to a deeper understanding of different trades and how they intersect and complement.

The Trades Innovation Centre is also named Murmuk-nganjin marnang, meaning 'We Work Hands', following engagement with representatives of the Wurundjeri Woi-wurrung Cultural Heritage Aboriginal Corporation.

Programs offered at the Trades Innovation Centre

The Trades Innovation Centre is offering a range of programs in which students benefit from simulations, sector-leading equipment and teaching practices, and programs that integrate job-ready and future-ready industry skills.

- Certificate II in Building and Construction Pre-apprenticeship
- Certificate II in Electrotechnology (Pre-vocational)
- Certificate II in Plumbing (Pre-apprenticeship)
- Certificate III in Carpentry
- Certificate III in Electrotechnology Electrician
- Diploma of Building and Construction (Building)
- Prepare to Work Safely in the Construction Industry
